

Senior Citizen Tuition for Credit Classes

RVC Administrative Procedure (4:10.120)

This procedure applies to eligible in district senior citizens seeking reduced or waived tuition for credit courses offered by Rock Valley College.

Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to outline the eligibility requirements, application process, and limitations related to senior citizen tuition waivers or reductions for credit classes.

Scope

An individual who meets the age, residency, and any additional eligibility requirements established by Illinois law and College policy to be at a reduced rate or tuition free. All other fees will be assessed at a full rate for students in both age categories. The tuition reduction is not applicable for enrollment in non-credit seminars, classes, or programs.

Department and Primary Point of Contact Involved

Department: Records and Registration

Primary Point of Contact: Registrar/Director of Records and Registration

Definitions

Eligible Senior Citizen

Resident students between the ages of 62-64 at the time of registration eligible for reduced tuition

Resident students 65 and over at the time of registration eligible for free tuition

Credit Course

A course offered by the College for academic credit that applies toward a degree or certificate.

Procedure

1. Eligible senior citizen provides Records and Registration with a valid driver license or State ID showing date of birth.
2. Records and Registration places waiver when applicable.
3. Records and Registration works with Accounts Receivable to ensure the waiver was applied. **Fees will still be applied.
